

Dear Carol,

The Battle Twinning Association would like to replace the sundial and plinth in the lower Almonry gardens as a memorial to Roy Calthorpe, as the present one is in need of repair or replacement. Originally when Roy was alive and as President of our Association, he was going to make up a plinth he saw more fitting. Unfortunately as you know he died a year ago.

So as a memorial we have in mind to replace it with a plinth as seen on the two attached photos. This be be surmounted by the sphere as in one of the photos. It would need to be mounted on a stone pavement type base to make it secure which would probably raise it up a couple of inches or so.

One of the photos shows the plinth with sphere on top the other with dimensions of the plinth.

Onto one of the panels would be attached a brass plate explaining that it was given by the BTA, what is and why it is there.

We were thinking it might be better on the terrace nearer the Almonry and it would make a feature there. It should be a safer place for it to be.

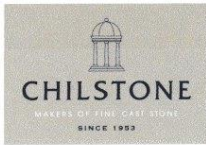
I am hoping this does not cause problems with present arrangements.

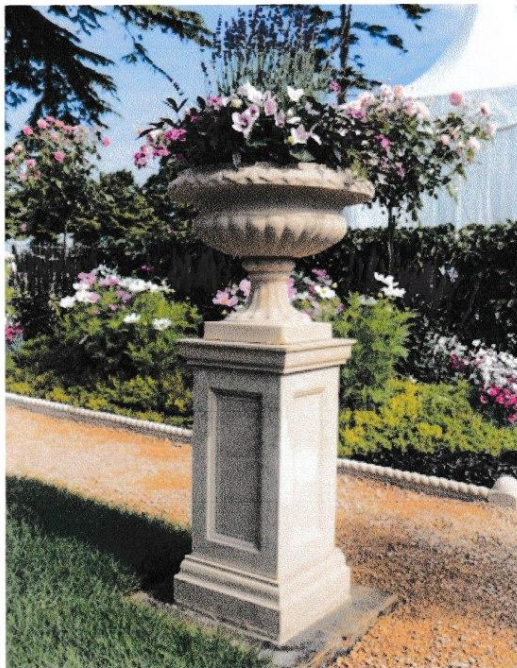
