This will include the Almonry front garden.

The rear garden will be worked on at a later date starting with the lower level. This will include the compost area, pond and Apothecary bed.

As there have been unwanted access problems at night we wonder if it would be possible to put railings along the back of the Museum. These could match the ones on the Market Square side.

The large shrubs along the rear wall could be cut back and replaced with berberis of various colours which would look better, let more light in and deter night visitors.

Unfortunately, now that one of our members no longer wishes to work in the rear Almonry garden, we are unable to brick the foot paths which means a contractor will be needed to do this part of the upper garden.

We will be doing some work on the upper level such as clearing dead plants and finishing off the top of the dividing wall to make that area safe.

Other work will have to go on hold until the building work is finished and all rubbish is removed.
