Police SpeedWatch Records.

This month Sussex Police have recorded 96 reports on Speedwatch sessions / 16 visits to support Community Groups.

Last month CSW group's generated 4,684 reports through Op Crackdown 143 of those reports are reports of abuse to groups from drivers.

In the last 12 months 69,767 reports were generated.

The Sussex Police repeat offenders compliance rate currently stands at 93.21%, this ratio is based on drivers who have received the first letter from us not going back through the CSW system within a 12 month period, (this data is based on group record input).
