Update from the Estates Committee

A list of features that reduce the carbon footprint included in the preferred provider's tender will be requested from the Technical Task & Finish Group, together with any enhancements that have been identified. This information will be required by the next meeting on 26th March. This will enable the group to seek advice about ways to reduce the pavilion's carbon footprint further with a view to applying for funding from the Strategic CIL Climate Emergency Bonus Fund.

Community Ownership Fund

Rural Community Infrastructure Grant

The Town Clerk submitted an application for £20,000 before the closing date of 29th February. A response is awaited.

British Gypsum

An application can be drafted for a financial donation and/or for a donation of materials, such as plaster, ceilings, drylining etc. ready for review at the next meeting.
